E.V.S—EUROPEAN VOLUNTEER SERVICE

The Voluntary European Service (SVE) offers to the European young persons the only opportunity to express his personal commitment across voluntary not remunerated and full-time activities, in a foreign country inside or out of the EU. Hereby, one seeks to develop the solidarity, the mutual comprehension and the tolerance between the young persons, helping to reinforce this way the social cohesion in the European Union and to promote the active citizenship of the young persons.

Opened all the young persons between 18 and 30, the EVS is really ' service of learning '. Not only he is of benefit to the local communities, by means of the participation in activities of voluntary work, the voluntary young persons can develop new skills and, therefore, improve his personal, educational and professional development.

Volunteers can benefit from a specific formation along the activity and to put in agreement on the awaited results of learning and the processes and methods that will be in use for reaching them. His experience of learning is recognized formally across a Youthpass (supporting diploma with validity in all the countries where any action of the program carries out Youth in Action).

The participation is free for the volunteers (with the exception of a contribution of 10 % of the travel expenses), that also receive housing and subsistence, coverage of insurance, an assignment or money of pocket during the project and a linguistic support.

Special conditions are applied to promote the participation of the young persons with fewer opportunities. For example, they can take part from the age of 16 years.
